

IN THE MATTER OF THE *SOCIETY ACT*

and

THE ROYAL WESTMINSTER REGIMENT ASSOCIATION

CONSTITUTION

(as amended March 11, 1987)

1. The name of the Society shall be the “The Royal Westminster Regiment Association”.
2. The purposes of the Society are;
 - (a) Ensure that the contribution of the Regiment to its City, County, Province and Nation is preserved in perpetuity by the operation of a Regimental Museum, and the publication of a written history of the Regiment and its antecedents dated from 1863;
 - (b) Ensure that the integrity of the documents, memorabilia and artifacts belonging to the Association without division and preservation thereof;
 - (c) To promote the welfare of the active Regiment and to give what support possible subject to the requirements of (a) and (b) above;
 - (d) To meet as occasion demands in a fraternal manner and to offer by example the need for stable, patriotic and contributing individuals in an orderly society.
