Who We Are

The Association was formed in 1947 by veterans of the Westminster Regiment who wanted to continue the strong bond and comradeship built during the war years. This tradition continues with our *General Membership* now comprising of current and formers members of the Royal Westminster Regiment, including the serving Battalion, the Royal Westminster Regiment Band, and the Regiment’s affiliated Cadet Corps. Recently, we have extended *Associate Membership* opportunities to current or former members of Canadian, Commonwealth or NATO Forces and their affiliated Cadet Corps, and direct descendants of Members of the 47th Battalion, 131st Battalion and/or The Westminster Regiment. Our focus is on supporting efforts to preserve the history and heritage of the Royal Westminster Regiment, and engaging with the Regiment to support serving and retired members.

Board of Directors

The Association is governed by a 13-member Board of Directors who are elected at the Annual General Meeting in May. The Board includes representatives from each of the Battalion’s three Messes. The Board meets once a month from September to June.

Main Efforts

The Association’s main efforts are as follows:

- **Melfa Golf Tournament** – held each year prior to the Melfa Dinner
- **Melfa Dinner** – held in May to commemorate the battle of the crossing of the Melfa River, in Italy, on 24 May 1944 and the award of the Victoria Cross to Major Mahony (pronounced Mah-anee).
- **Barbeques for the Soldiers** – planned for the start and end of the Battalion’s training year, and for special events as requested by Association Members
- **Bursaries for Soldiers** – are presented every year at the Melfa Dinner to for up to three serving members of the Battalion in order to assist with the costs of higher education
- **Donation to the Regimental Fund** – is presented each year at the Soldier’s Christmas Dinner
- **Donations on Behalf of Bereaved Members** – make to charitable organizations to honour the passing of loved-ones
- **Gift Cards for Celebratory Events** – on occasions such as births and marriages
- **Support of the Poppy Fund** – through purchase of Remembrance Day wreaths and donations
- **Remembrance Day** – Association Members actively participate in Remembrance Day Ceremonies
- **Hyack Parade** – the Association is represented in the annual Hyack Parade in New Westminster

Groundsheet

The Association publishes a quarterly newsletter called “The Groundsheet” to keep members up to date on the Regimental activities of the serving Battalion, Band, affiliated Cadet Corps and Museum, along with news of former members and what the Association is doing.
